The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To *Susannah's House*.

Susannah's House is an Intensive Outpatient Recovery Program for mothers in recovery. Their mission is to provide a source of help and hope in a therapeutic, faith-based community for women and their children to break adverse cycles and rebuild their families.

In 2022, 90 mothers, infants and children were served, and a beautiful new housing facility was built to house eight pregnant or post-partum moms and their infants while they attend treatment and for as long as they need it. Susannah's House helps families be reunited and infants to remain with their mothers.

Donations can be made by sending a check to Good Sam, specifying "*Susannah's House*" in the memo line, or through Good Sam's online giving portal by scanning the QR code at right.

Last week's offering of \$438 has been designated to go to the Helping Mamas Knoxville.

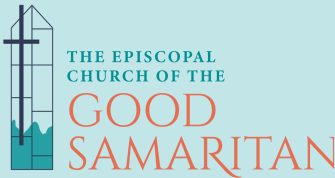
