BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS

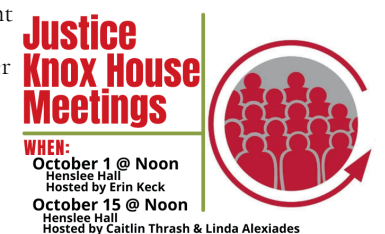

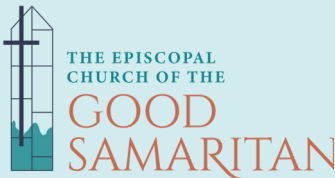
