JUSTICE KNOX NEHEMIAH ACTION ASSEMBLY

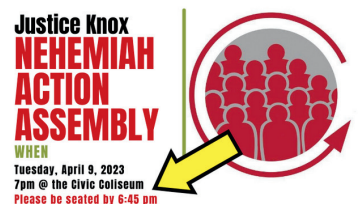
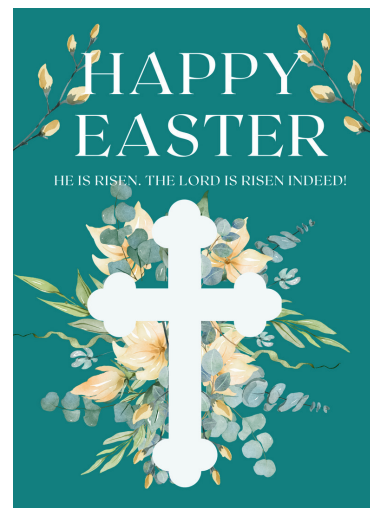

The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To The Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem

The Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem includes nearly 7,000 Anglicans throughout Israel, Palestine, Lebanon, Jordan, and Syria. While this region is the birthplace of Christianity, the Diocese must navigate the various laws in each of these countries, which makes their mission difficult. Despite these challenges, the Diocese is engaged in many worthwhile activities, such as the Diocesan Department for Peace, Reconciliation and Interfaith Dialogue, the Diocesan guesthouses for pilgrims to the region, and the Diocesan Women's ministry. All these ministries are especially important, and the tension and tragedy of the region makes our contributions impactful.

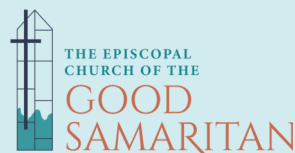
