The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To The Episcopal Diocese of South Dakota

The Diocese of South Dakota is the companion diocese to the Diocese of East Tennessee. This diocese was established in 1871 as the Missionary District of Niobrara and was primarily focused on the spiritual life and development of Dakota and Lakota Sioux people. In 1971, the Missionary District became the Diocese of South Dakota. Currently, the diocese is composed of 12,000 baptized members in 76 congregations. More than one half of its members are indigenous people, and most live in communities which have a poverty rate of 49%. The money that we give today will support the various Episcopal ministries working to improve the lives of these strong but struggling members of our Church community.
