This year we'll address issues of homelessness, education, and economic instability in the Knoxville community. The Nehemiah Action Assembly is the culmination of this year's work. We'd love to have a HUGE Good Sam presence.

The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To Justice Knox.

Justice Knox, an interfaith collaboration of congregations and organizations, actively uncovers injustice and mobilizes the community to create just, fair, and effective solutions. Through Justice Knox, congregations act together in response to the scriptural mandate to "do justice." After researching problems in our community and identifying the power holders who have the authority to implement the solutions, members gather in a large public meeting called a Nehemiah Action Assembly to call for action from community officials. After the Nehemiah Action Assembly, they gather to celebrate their work and victories and invite people to own the work through investment in Justice Knox.
