EVENT REGISTRATIONS OPEN!

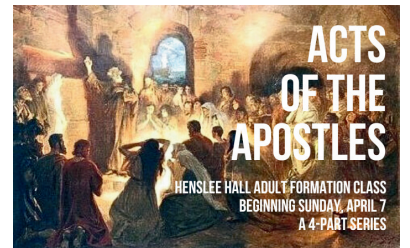

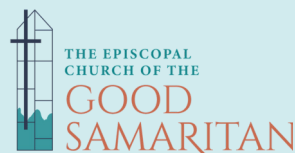
