### The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To Healthy Ways Clinic at East Tennessee Children's Hospital.

Healthy Ways Clinic is a program at East Tennessee Children's Hospital that works with children and adolescents struggling with overweight and obesity. HWC is led by a multidisciplinary team (dietitian, psychologist, physical therapist, and medical doctor) that focuses on healthy habits and lifestyle changes. In addition to excess body weight, many of the children and teens are developing or have developed other chronic diseases such as diabetes, liver disease, heart disease or sleep apnea. Also, many of the kids report being bullied or teased about their body size. Healthy Ways Clinic works with families to address overall well-being including healthy diet, physical activity, sleep, coping skills, and positive relationships. Your donations will help enhance the work of the Healthy Ways Clinic.

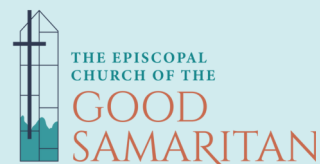
