The Cash In The Plate For Today Goes To Planned Parenthood.

Planned Parenthood is one of the nation's leading providers of high-quality, affordable health care, and the nation's largest provider of sex education. The Knoxville Planned Parenthood office plans to reopen in October, after a 2.5-year closure since the building was destroyed by arson. Planned Parenthood offers medical services such as wellness exams, pregnancy testing and counseling, contraception options, and cancer screenings. Payment for services is income-based which provides more affordable healthcare for the uninsured and underinsured individual. Donations are needed to continue these important services.

Donations can be made by sending a check to Good Sam, specifying *"Planned Parenthood"* in the memo line, or through Good Sam's online giving portal by scanning the QR code at right.
