OUTREACH PROJECT

The Empty Stocking Fund is a volunteer-run organization focused on helping East Tennessee families experiencing food insecurity. This season, the ESF volunteer team plans to distribute 3,000 baskets of food that provide a nutritious holiday meal plus enough staples to get through a week. As requests for food increase, the ESF team is working to meet the demand. The ESF is a non-profit organization of the Knoxville News Sentinel that started in 1912 as a project to feed families at Christmas. Now, more than 100 years later, this organization continues to focus on the needs in our community.

Last week's offering of \$1,581.00 has been designated to go to The Diocese of Western North Carolina Hurricane Helene Relief.


