HELPING MAMAS SERVICE PROJECT

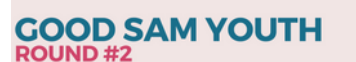
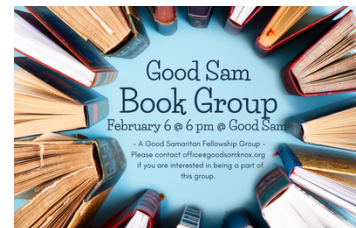

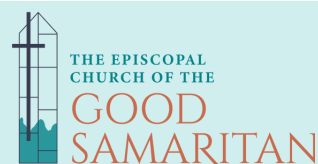
