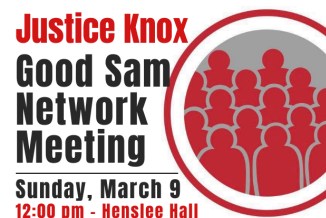


MARDI GRAS PARTY AND SILENT AUCTION

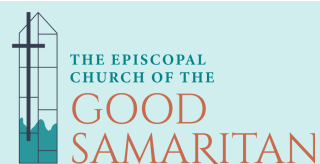
