### SOUP, SALAD, & COMPLINE

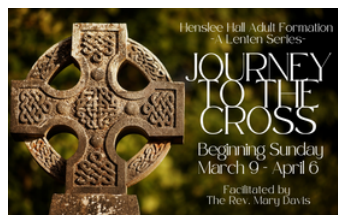

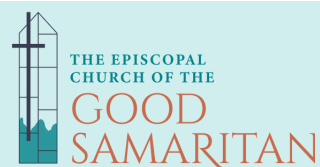
