The Cash In The Plate For CONTACT Care Line

CONTACT Care line provides free and compassionate emotional support to people in suicidal crisis or emotional distress through confidential telephone, internet chat, and text services. Their Reassurance Program provides regular phone calls to elderly or homebound individuals who have little or no caregiver support. As part of the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline, CONTACT Care Line answers calls, texts, and chats for residents of the greater Knoxville, TN, area and beyond. LOSS – Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors – involves trained suicide loss survivors going to the scene of a suicide to provide immediate, voluntary support to those left behind. They have both English and Spanish lines. They provide a lifeline to those that have nowhere else to call. For more information, see their website at https://contactlistens.org/about.
