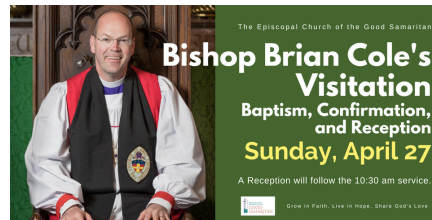

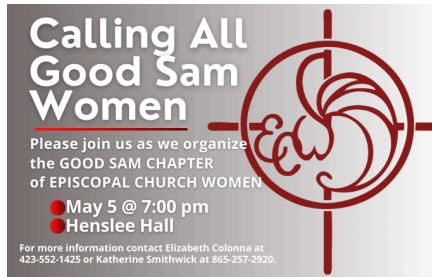
NEW ADULT FORMATION: ALL YOU NEED IS LOVE

The Cash In The Plate goes to the Diocese of Kondoa

Our companion Diocese of Kondoa is a missionary diocese in a predominately Muslim area in Tanzania. Bishop Given Gaula and his wife, Rev. Lilian Gaula, have been in Kondoa for over 10 years. Under their leadership, the number of Christians has more than tripled. Good Sam has been blessed to host them on several of their visits. Bishop Given has started a Christian primary school which is thriving. A secondary school in Chemba is under construction and nearly completed. Your donations will be used for the final work needed to complete the secondary school and to start a scholarship fund for students. It costs \$400 a year for a child to attend the primary school - this includes meals, transportation and uniforms. The anticipated cost for a boarder at the secondary school will be \$900 a year. In addition to your donations to help support these friends, consider going on a pilgrimage to Kondoa. It is a life-changing experience.

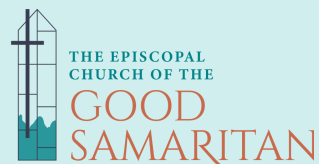
