PALM SUNDAY AND EASTER EGG HUNT

Palm Sunday - and the beginning of Holy Week - is next Sunday, April 13. Holy Eucharist Rite I begins at 8:15 am. At the 10:30 am service, we will begin the Procession of the Palms outside in the back parking lot, weather permitting. Between the services at 9:30 am, the younger children will hear a brief lesson in the Chapel while the older youth hide the eggs. After the lesson, the children will proceed outside to hunt for the eggs. (In case of inclement weather, the eggs will be hidden downstairs.) Parents, make sure your children bring a basket to collect their eggs! The nursery will be available all morning as usual There will be no Sunday School, Lectionary Class or Adult Formation on Palm Sunday.
