#### FLOWERING THE CROSS

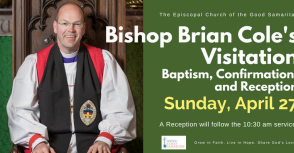
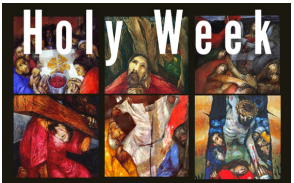

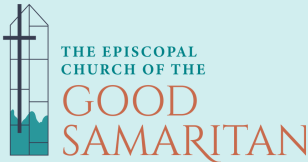
