SPRING WORK DAY - HELP NEEDED

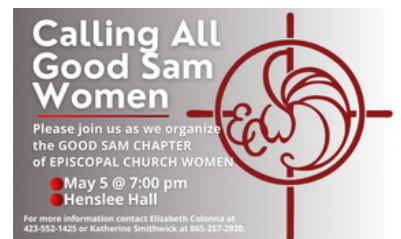
