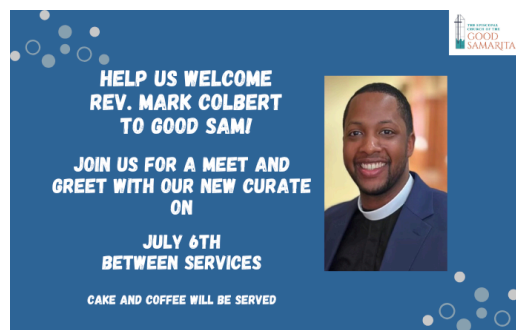
REGISTRATION OPEN FOR VBS

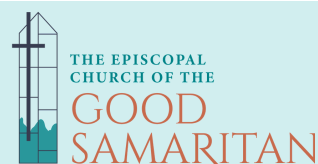
