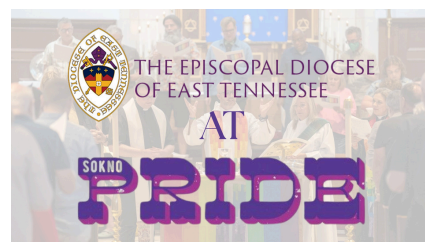

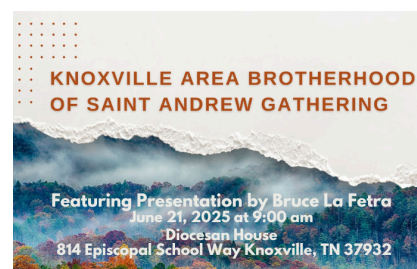
DIocese OF EAST TENNESSEE AT SoKNO PRIDE

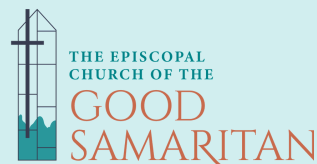
