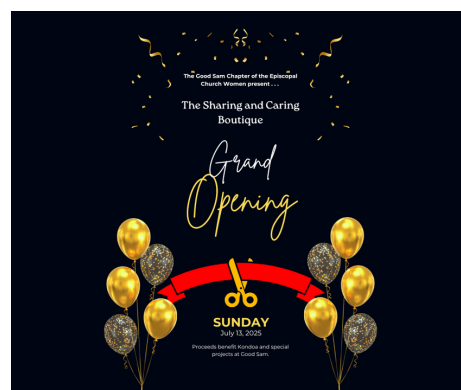
GOOD SAM SUNDAY PICNIC

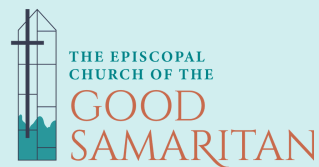
