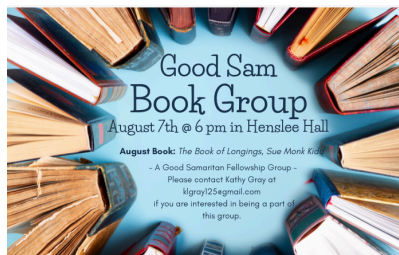
IMPORTANT ECW MEETING

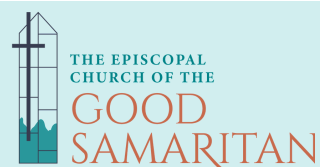
