VESTRY NOMINATING COMMITTEE

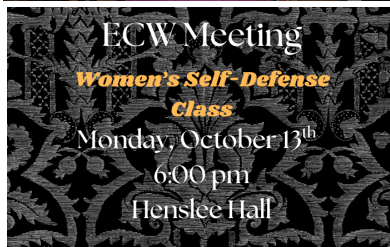

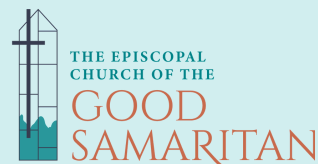
