#### ECW MEETING CHANGE FOR OCTOBER

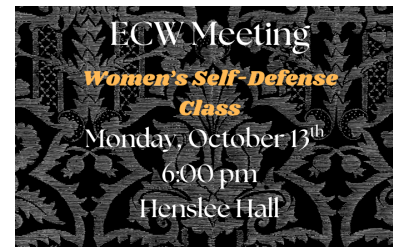
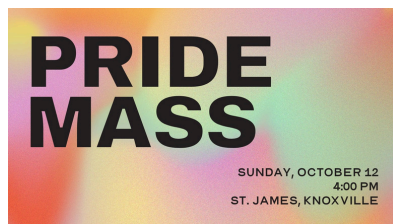

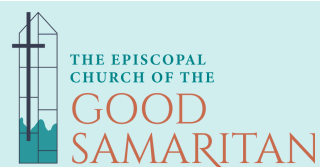
