The Cash In The Plate goes to Episcopal Relief and Development Response to Alaska Hurricane

Episcopal Relief & Development (ERD) is supporting the disaster response in Alaska through its U.S. Disaster Program, which partners with local organizations to provide immediate and long-term recovery support following natural disasters. ERD's Hurricane Relief Fund is the primary channel for donations, enabling partners to provide critical supplies, humanitarian aid, and support for rebuilding. Thousands of Alaskans, most of them indigenous, will not be able to return home for at least 18 months according to the governor of Alaska.

Donations can be made by sending a check to Good Sam, specifying "ERD-Alaska" in the memo line, or through Good Sam's online giving portal by scanning the QR code at right.

Last week's offering \$1049.96 has been designated to go to Remote Area Medical.

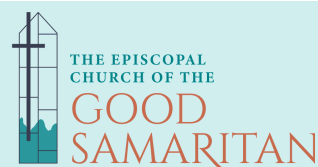
