### COMMUNION TRAINING

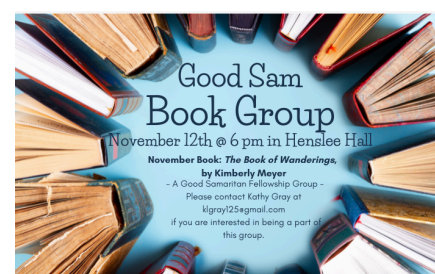

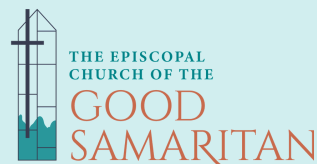
