ROMEO

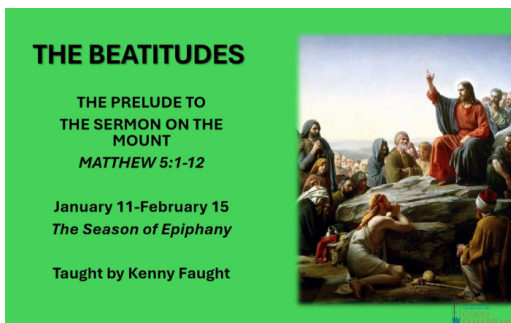
On Wednesday, January 14th, ROMEO (Really Old Men Eating Out) will meet at 11:15 at Parkside Grill. Please join them for some food and fun!

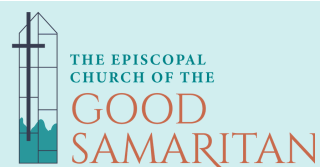
