SMSW MEETING

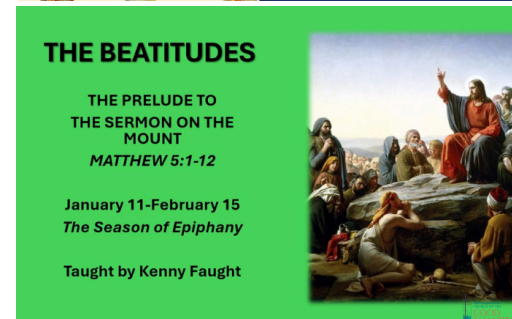

Episcopal Relief & Development is in close contact with our partners, including local dioceses and agencies in Jamaica, Cuba and Haiti, as Hurricane Melissa caused widespread devastation throughout the Caribbean region. The storm is the strongest hurricane in Jamaica's history and one of the most powerful Atlantic storms on record. Hurricane Melissa left approximately 77% of the island without power and displaced more than 6,000 people. 102 deaths are attributed to Hurricane Melissa in Jamaica and Haiti.

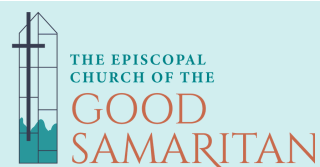
