MISSION TRIP SILENT AUCTION

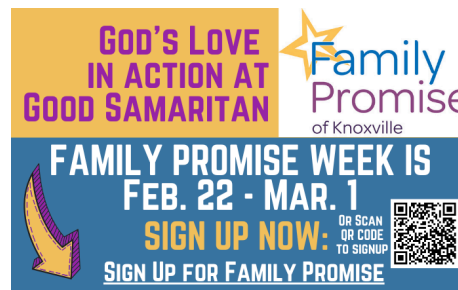
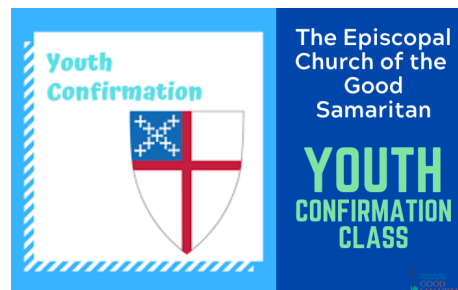

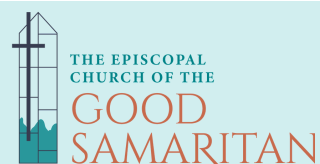
