YOUTH CONFIRMATION CLASS

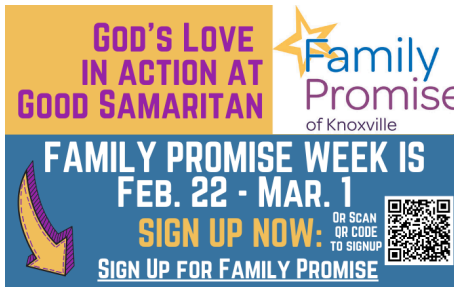

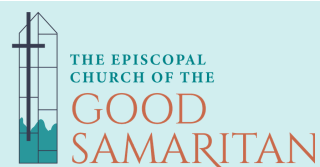
