Episcopal Relief & Development is asking for donations to support communities affected by the ongoing drought in Kitui and Marsabit counties, where consecutive seasons of insufficient rainfall have sharply reduced access to food and water and undermined the local economy. The impacts are particularly acute in arid and semi-arid areas, where households rely heavily on rain-fed agriculture and pasturing animals. Thousands of people are facing rising food prices, water scarcity, and declining livestock productivity.

Donations can be made by sending a check to Good Sam, specifying "ERD - Drought Response" in the memo line, or through Good Sam's online giving portal by scanning the QR code at right.

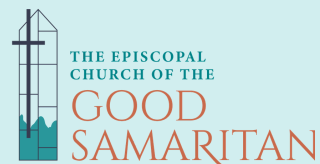
