EASTER BRUNCH

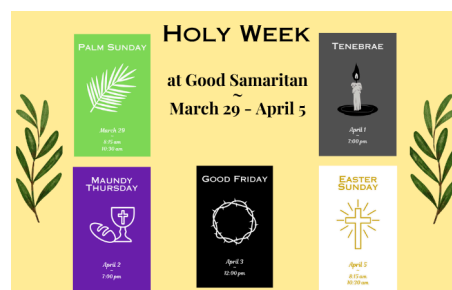

The Love Kitchen served its first meals on 2-14-1986, and continues to provide meals and emergency food packages to homebound, homeless and unemployed people of all races and faiths. The Love Kitchen works with local agencies to provide meals and donate services in the hope of promoting the self-sufficiency of those served. Each week The Love Kitchen serves over 500 meals in house and delivers over 3,000 to homes. Following the vision of founder Helen Ashe, The Love Kitchen is operated almost entirely through volunteers, thus maximizing the impact of donations.

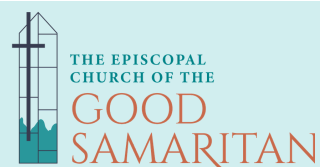
